
## Short Review: "Brainwaves" (1982) by Dr. John L. Flynn

A silly, unremarkable thriller that plays out like an episode of "Quincy" rather than a legitimate sci-fi movie. When a young woman (Love) is injured in an automobile accident and ends up hospitalized in a coma, she receives the brainwaves of a murdered girl in a bizarre transplant conducted by a mad doctor (Curtis). Her newly revived brain experiences a series of flashbacks in which she recalls the murderer. But before she can tell the police, the dead girl's assailant begins stalking her. Not very original!!!
